Dear Parents,

Along with the official word of the visit of Pope Francis to the upcoming World Meeting of Families, we have been notified of a change to next year's academic year. It has been announced that there will be no classes for any of the Catholic schools in Archdiocese of Philadelphia from Wednesday, September 23, 2015 through Friday, September 25, 2015.

The instructional time that will be lost for those days must be made up to maintain the educational integrity of our programs. For now, we will be having school on two holydays of obligation for the upcoming school year: December 8th (Immaculate Conception) and May 14th (Ascension Thursday). We are investigating ways to make up the remaining day of instructional time.

Too, looking at the calendar for next year, it appears that due to the lateness of Labor Day, we may be starting in advance of Labor Day. We have contacted Central Bucks School District and are awaiting their decision. As soon as we are notified, we will share the information with you.


