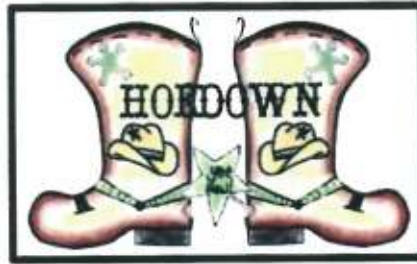

When you place your order for scrip be sure to send in an order form with your payment every time.

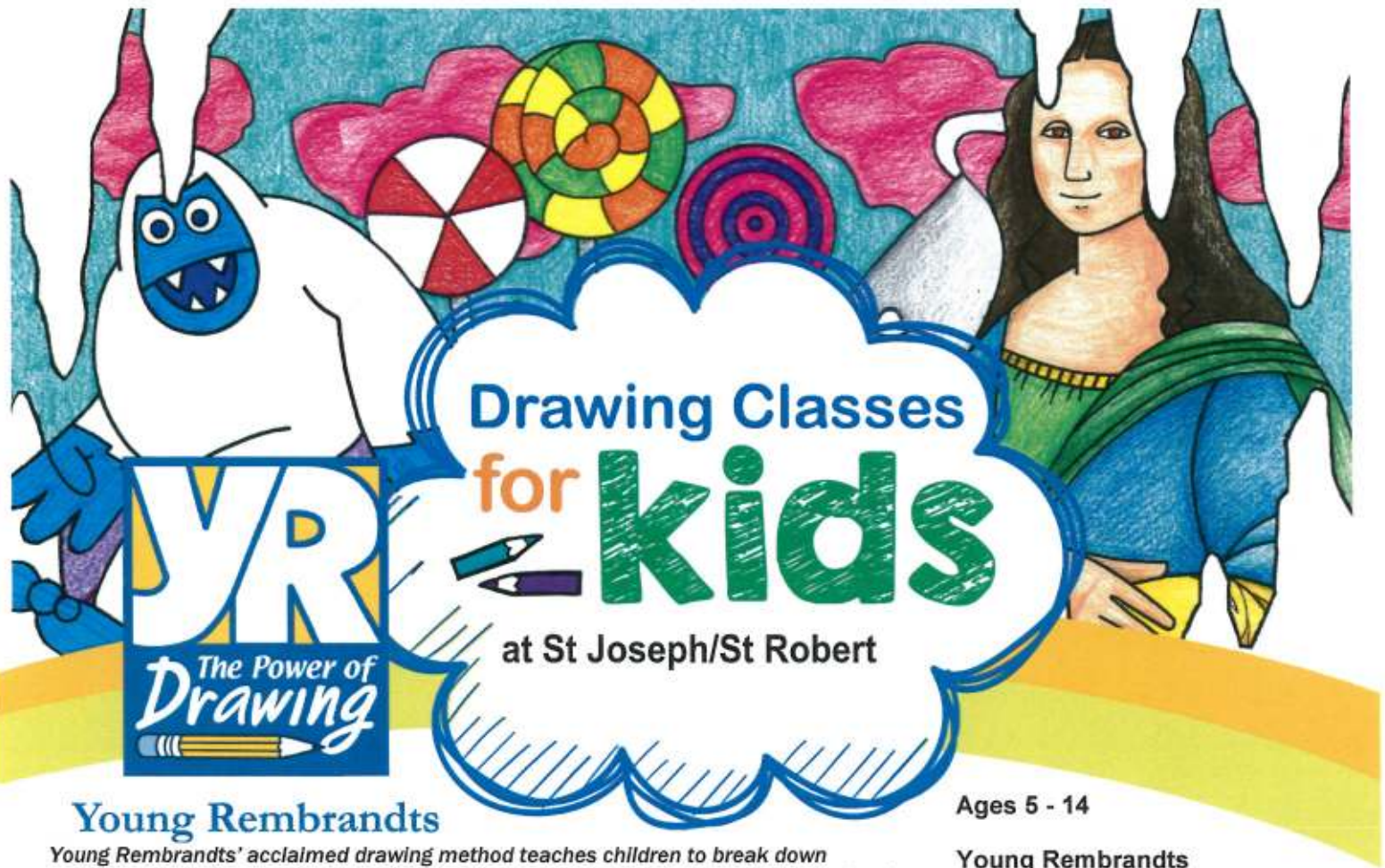
This is how your rebates are tracked.

So far during this school year, families have saved \$13,800 on tuition by using scrip.

It is not too late to sign up online to use "My Scrip Wallet" to purchase e-cards. Send a request for the enrollment code jackiescrip@stjstr.org.

Just a reminder ~ physical cards earn 4% whether purchased on line or through school.

Ecards are eligible for the full rebate amount. Some are as high as 15%.
