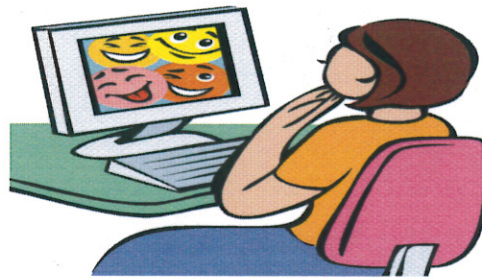

Tuition Assistance for 2016/2017 – Submission Deadline Extension: March 31, 2016

Attached to this week’s communication is information regarding the new application process for financial aid for next year. It is also recommended that you visit: www.Blocs.org and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review, and if you qualify it is strongly recommended that you apply. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12th. Families with one dependent must have an annual income of less than \$91,620.

For each additional dependent, you can make an additional \$15,270 per child. Through the generosity of businesses that have allocated their tax dollars to SJR, we were able to provide tuition assistance to 20 students for the 2015-2016 academic year.
