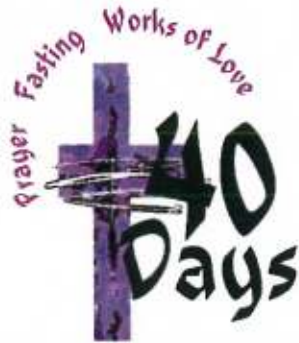

### Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Who should complete this aid application?**

**Q: Why do I need to input my spouse's information if I am remarried and they are not legally responsible for my children?**

A: Smart Aid's calculation works off of the total household income, therefore including all income, whether the party is legally responsible for your children or not. Our system however, does take into effect your spouse's expenses as well as their income. It is important to list all expenses that are asked of within the application.

**Q: I do not have the required tax documents. HELP!**

A: You are required to include ONLY tax information from the 2016 return. These should be uploaded after you have filed your 2016 return. If you are asked for a specific line from a tax document that you have not yet completed, please estimate the projected amount.

**Q: How will I know if I qualify for aid or not?**

A: We do not disclose information about the results of your application. All final tuition aid decisions, including notification of an award amount (if any); will be made by your school. For the date award notices will be given, please contact your school directly.

**Q: What if I want to edit my application?**

The Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program provides tuition assistance to qualified families through the generosity of businesses contributing under guidelines provided by Pennsylvania legislation. Catholic school families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12<sup>th</sup> and are residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Income guidelines for 2017 are listed below. Families with these income guidelines are strongly encouraged to submit application:

5	\$152,700 (add \$15,270 for each additional dependent)

Meeting EITC Guidelines does not guarantee every family tuition assistance. Grants are based on the funding available and the family's ranking among all qualified applicants. We ask that you take advantage of this opportunity to receive tuition assistance. All awards will be applied towards school year 2017-2018.
