XL Update - eCommunication 5/3/2017

At the end of November, 2016, we proudly reported on the pilot program Ms. Macrone's Math classes began using: online "IXL Math" for skills practice through their subscription service. IXL is a skills practice website with thousands of problems just waiting to be solved online! Last week, the IXL Dean of Students sent a "Certificate of Achievement" to announce that the students involved in the program have successfully completed 30,000 math questions! That's 20,000 more problems than we reported in November, 2016!!! Congratulations to Ms. Macrone's 7th grade Pre-Algebra and 8th grade Honors Math students on meeting this challenge before the end of April!! A copy of the certificate is attached to this e-communication.

The best part is, even without a subscription, anyone can access and use IXL Math for daily math practice! Simply go to www.ixl.com, select math, a grade level and a topic. Students can practice up to 20 questions/day without a subscription. It is a great way to hone a variety of Math skills at no charge!

JUST A THOUGHT: As we move through these weekends, we are in the midst of a special time I think of as "Holy Communion Season". The past two weekends and this upcoming weekend are times when our students will receive the Eucharist for the first time. 
