Dear Families,

Welcome back! I can't tell you how exciting it was to see all of you this week for the first days of school and for the visiting days of our youngest students. Tomorrow will be our first day altogether as a community of learners from Pre-K -8th grade. I can't wait! I know that the transition from the more flexible schedule of summer to the school schedule can be difficult for some students and families. Let me assure you that the faculty is aware of this, too. They will not be permitted to walk across the parking lot to a waiting car. Please pull in to the lot, park the car and wait in the designated area across from the main entrance.

I'm excited to announce that our newly formed Safety Patrol will be assisting with morning arrival and dismissal at SJR. I'm so thankful to our 8th grade student leaders for providing this valuable service to our school.

Thank you for your prayers as I begin the school year in my new role as principal. It is a pleasure and a privilege.

Dear Parents:

As the beginning of the new school year approaches, Northeastern Music Programs invites your child to join your school's instrumental music program. There will be a virtual parent meeting scheduled for your school in early in the school year. The date of your school's meeting will be shared with your child at the instrument demonstration assembly at the beginning of the year.

*Our program is open to all students in grades 4-8, while some schools begin violin in 3^{rd} grade. Check with your school for the exact eligibility requirements.



INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC FAQs FOR PARENTS



Does my child need to know how to play an instrument to join?

No. We teach your child everything he/she needs to know to play their musical instrument.

When do lessons begin for students?

First lesson dates vary by school. Dates are listed on the enrollment page when you register your child for lessons. Once registered, you can expect an email from your child's teacher within a week of the first lesson.

When do lessons occur?

Your child will receive one (1) small group lesson each week. All lessons are scheduled during the school day.

How long are lessons? How much class time will be missed?

All lessons are 30 minutes long and meet on a rotating schedule. Students do not miss the same class each week. In most situations, students will not miss the same time more than once a grading cycle.

How much does participation cost?

There are two components to participation in the program: tuition and a **quality** musical instrument. Refer to the attached flyers for tuition and rental instrument pricing.

If my child doesn't sign up now, will he/she be able to later?

Although we do not recommend delaying enrollment in the program, we do welcome registrations throughout the year. Students that join the program mid-year will have to work diligently to catch up to their peers. Our teachers will do their best to get your child caught up.

Will participation affect my child's grades in other subjects?

It will almost surely help them. Research has shown that band has a positive influence on other studies. Music students consistently average higher grades than non-music students,

Can you be in the band/orchestra and be involved in other school activities like sports, cheerleading, dance, step, chorus, or art?

Absolutely! Most of our music students are involved in other electives and activities.

My child is involved in so many activities. Won't those activities affect his/her performance in band/orchestra and vice versa?

Music students often have many varied interests that make them among the busiest students in the school. The experience that they gain in balancing these interests and activities often proves to be one of life's most valuable lessons.


What should I do if my child is struggling?

Practice is a key component for improvement; students must practice to improve. If your child is practicing and still struggling with their instrument, contact your child's music teacher for suggestions. Above all else, remain positive and encouraging as your child learns this new skill.

Will my child have an opportunity to perform?

Yes! For beginning students, your child will have at least 1 performance this year. For advanced students, there will be a minimum of 2 performance per year. In addition to school concerts, there are other opportunities to perform in our annual Northeastern Honor Band festival, Archdiocese festivals, and other performances arranged by your child's teacher.


