News from the Advancement Director

A reminder that the Educational Improvement Tax Credit Scholarship family income levels for the current 2022-2023 school year has increase. Families who did not previously meet the income qualifications for tuition scholarships through the EITC/BLOCS program may now qualify with the higher income threshold. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K to 12th grade. These tuition scholarships can offset the cost of your child's Catholic education. The paperwork to determine eligibility must be submitted by September 30th. Please see the attached flyer or call and speak to our Advancement Director, Mrs. Kathy Williamson.

Opportunities and Reminders


With the success of the Pre-K, Kindergarten, and First Grade Summer Playgroup we are excited to continue meeting on the playground throughout September & October.




