

Dear SJR Families,





He noted that a few Saint Vincent de Paul folks (He has been involved with the St. Roberts chapter for 10+ years) go out every Saturday to find/feed the homeless, primarily in the Kensington area. He shared that this is a very difficult/humbling experience. In the winter months, they provide hot soup and sandwiches (700 sandwiches provided the last time that he was able to assist -- 12/17/22).

They had a few warm clothes donations that they also handed out that day, some new/some used (scarves/sweaters/gloves/hats/coats)...it was obvious that the need was greater than the supplies that they had on the 17th. Tom requested that any SJR families who have a donation of new or gently used warm adult clothing send it to school. We have some collection boxes for that purpose.
