Dear SJR Families,

As we begin this time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, I'm recalling my time teaching in Pre-K. Nobody is too young to learn the importance of sacrifice. We can define it for our young children as giving something up so for somebody else. After you talk about it, you will notice it and be able to reinforce it. Children sacrifice their own wants when they share with their friends. They often need to set aside what they want so that a sibling or parent can have their needs met - like when they want to go to the playground after school but need to go with their young sibling to the doctor. These are all small sacrifices. When you start to use that language, you can help your child become aware of the importance of empathy and sacrifice and feel good about their growing ability to do both.

Your child will be bringing home the collection box from the Missionary Childhood Association. Ms. Ali Holden spoke to the students just after Catholic Schools Week about how we can help people all over the world. During Lent, your child can put pennies in there to bring back to school after Easter.

Thank you for all you do for SJR! Our school and your family will be in my prayers in a special way during this holy season.


Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) BLOCS Tuition Scholarships for 2023-2024

Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2023-2024 academic year is now open. Before applying, please visit: www.Blocs.org and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review. We recommend that you apply even if you are over the annual income. If available, your family may qualify for other sources of tuition funding. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12th.

The 2023-2024 family income level is \$105,183. The allowance for each dependent is \$18,514. For example, a family with one dependent can have an income level of \$123,697 (\$105,183 + \$18,514) or less to qualify. If a family has two dependents, then the income level would be \$142,211, and the increase of \$18,514 would continue for each dependent.

Applications for tuition scholarships are completed through FACTS by visiting:
 http://blocs.org/apply-scholarship/ The application fee is \$30.00 & all
 submissions are strictly confidential. Once you complete an online application,
 you will be required to attach your 2022 Federal Tax forms and all supporting tax
 schedules. Everything must be submitted to FACTS by May 25, 2023 to determine
 your family's eligibility for tuition scholarship. Families will be notified of their
 award in August.


