I'm very excited to have the process officially underway! Please enroll your child as soon as possible.

All submissions are strictly confidential. Once you complete an online application, you will be required to attach your 2022 Federal Tax forms and all supporting tax schedules. Everything must be submitted to FACTS by May 25, 2023 to determine your family's eligibility for tuition scholarship. Families will be notified of their award in August.

Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) BLOCS Tuition Scholarships for 2023-2024


Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2023-2024 academic year is now open. Before applying, please visit: www.Blocs.org and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review. We recommend that you apply even if you are over the annual income. If available, your family may qualify for other sources of tuition funding. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12th.

The 2023-2024 family income level is \$105,183. The allowance for each dependent is \$18,514. For example, a family with one dependent can have an income level of \$123,697 (\$105,183 + \$18,514) or less to qualify. If a family has two dependents, then the income level would be \$142,211, and the increase of \$18,514 would continue for each dependent.
