

We are looking for nominations for a Treasurer and Vice President for the 2023/24 school year!

Vice President:

• The Vice President, in the absence of the President, shall perform all the duties of the President. The Vice President will also be responsible for setting up and maintaining school assemblies in consultation with the Principal. In addition, the Vice President will serve as spokesperson for the committee heads unable to attend meetings.

Treasurer:

• The Treasurer shall receive all monies and shall make disbursements as directed by the Executive Board and countersigned by either Pastor. The Treasurer shall also prepare a written report relating to receipts and disbursements for the preceding school year for the first general membership meeting. This report should be distributed at the first general meeting. The Treasurer shall also prepare a final report to the Executive Board at the end of the current school year. This report would be used as a guide for the proposed budget for the following school year to be available at each Executive Board Meeting and then be presented to the general membership at each Home and School Association general meeting.
