The Bucks IU, Act 89 Mobile Fab Lab kicked off its year with a residency at St. Joseph/St. Robert school in Warrington. We were lucky enough to work with students from first through 8th grade! The classes used lasers to cut out fall leaves and design custom phone holders as well as 3D printers to create keychains. We used our inference skills to discover how robots use sensors and fabricated code to navigate mazes with our Sphero bots. Student creativity and a warm, welcoming environment were on display all week!



### From Our Director of Advancement....

Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2023-2024 academic year continues to be open. Your family may be eligible for tuition assistance. Please see the flyer for how you can benefit. The deadline is fast approaching!

There is another way the EITC program can benefit you and our school. If you have a Pennsylvania tax burden of \$1,000 or more, you can sign up for the EITC program and, instead of paying your state taxes to Pennsylvania, direct that money to our school. Isn't that incredible? Even more incredibly, you then get a 90% tax credit the following year. If you believe in Catholic education and you want to control your tax dollars – this is the program for you. ### Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) BLOCS Tuition Scholarships for 2023-2024

Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2023-2024 academic year continues to be open. Before applying, please visit: https://www.blocs.org/scholarship-faqs and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review. We recommend that you apply even if you are over the annual income. If available, your family may qualify for other sources of tuition funding. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12th .

The 2023-2024 family income level is \$105,183. The allowance for each dependent is \$18,514. For example, a family with one dependent can have an income level of \$123,697 (\$105,183 + \$18,514) or less to qualify. If a family has two dependents, then the income level would be \$142,211, and the increase of \$18,514 would continue for each dependent.

Applications for tuition scholarships are completed through FACTS by visiting: https://online.factsmgt.com/aid. The application fee is \$30.00 & Damp; all submissions are strictly confidential. Once you complete an online application, you will be required to attach your 2021 or 2022 Federal Tax forms and all supporting tax schedules. Everything must be submitted to FACTS by September 30, 2023 to determine your family's eligibility for tuition scholarship. If qualified, Mrs. Dorothy Aschenbrenner, SJR Business Manager will notify the family of their award.
