Dear SJR Families,

As we pray for peace in the Middle East and around the world, we are acutely aware that strife, discord, and violence exist. At school that means we plan and practice safety drills. This month we will be having our first "Intruder on Campus" drill. Sergeant Fuller, of the Warrington Police Department, met with our faculty in September to review our plan and to reinforce the importance of our situational awareness and the ability of leaders to make decisions under stress. He also toured some of the individual classrooms to answer questions about the best place to have children hide should that be the best decision in the moment. We reviewed safety practices. Teachers will be preparing students for the drill using age appropriate language about this emergency drill which will take place next Monday, October 23rd. Your child may have questions for you or may talk about it with you upon completion and so I wanted to make you aware ahead of time.

As we pray for peace in the Middle East and around the world, we also continue to reach out to those in our community. Every Saturday, members of The Saint Vincent de Paul Society from many churches in the archdiocese gather together to package food for our brothers and sisters in Christ -- 700 sandwiches/snacks/water/hot soup (fall/winter). They go to "find" the homeless and forgotten in the Kensington area to bring a smile to many faces, with a message that God loves them. They often pray with our brothers and sisters and tell them that God loves them. This ministry has gone to Philadelphia for 3 years and has provided over 100,000 sandwiches to those in need. They have asked us again this year to support that effort by sending in new or gently used outer clothes - sweatshirts, hoodies, coats, socks, scarves, hats, gloves, etc. that they can distribute along with the food. There will be a collection box in the main entrance of the school where your child can place any donations when they come to school each day.

As we pray for peace in the Middle East and in the world, please consider joining us at St. Robert's Church on Tuesday, October 24th at 6:30p.m. for a Holy Hour of Worship and Praise that is geared towards families with children and lead by Bill Monaghan. There will be music and meditation and benediction. It is a beautiful opportunity to come together during this time.


#### Art:
