SJR Candy Grams are back!


On Tuesday, February 13, the SJR Home & School Association will be acting as cupid and will be delivering personalized candy grams to students and faculty!

- Please make sure you select Warminster as your location. Choose your preferred pick-up method (Drive-thru, Dine-in or Carry-out).
- 3. Select menu item(s) for your order and click "add to order"
- 4. When finished adding items to your order click "My Order" and then "Continue to checkout".
- "It's a Community Care Event" screen will appear. Enter the school code sjrschool and then click the "Yes, I'd like to support" button. (The code is case sensitive.)
- 6. Review your order details and click "Complete my order".
- 7. When you arrive at Chick-fil-A click the "I'm here" and follow any additional prompts.
