Dear SJR Families,

We had a wonderful visit from Sister Margaret Rose Adams, the Assistant Superintendent of Elementary Education for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, yesterday. She and I reviewed some administrative issues and then I escorted her throughout the building to visit each classroom. She was impressed by her interactions with the students and the Catholic identity that is evident throughout the building. I am grateful for the support of The Archdiocese and Sister Margaret in particular.

Last week, I had the opportunity to see the movie, "Cabrini." It is a powerful movie about St. Frances Cabrini who came to America in 1889 to serve the immigrant children in New York. St. Frances Cabrini, though born in Italy, later became an American citizen and, thus, her canonization made her America's first saint. (The first saint who was born in America was Elizabeth Seton.) The Ambassador's Fund of the Archdiocese is providing a field trip for our 7th and 8th graders to see the movie on March 11th. Though the movie is not suitable for students younger than that, as it depicts the difficulties of poverty in the 1800s quite starkly, I wanted to share it with parents so that you could think about purchasing tickets and seeing the movie. It is a powerful movie about a powerful woman. You can find more information at https://www.angel.com/tickets/cabrini. I recommend it highly.

A reminder to please be sure to complete the enrollment process for your child going into grades 1-8 as soon as possible. This is the last week when the early enrollment fee is available. On Monday morning, the enrollment fee increases from \$100 to \$175 for those who have not made other arrangements with the office.

The InView test is Friday and Terra Nova testing begins on Monday morning for students in grades 2-7. It is particularly important that the students are in school on time and ready to go. They have been discussing testing and have had the opportunity for practice tests this week.

Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) BLOCS Tuition Scholarships for 2024-2025

Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2024-2025 academic year is now open. Before applying, please visit: https://www.blocs.org/scholarship-faqs and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review. We recommend that you apply even if you are over the annual income. If available, your family may qualify for other sources of tuition funding. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12th.

The 2024-2025 family income level is \$108,444. The allowance for each child is \$19,088. For example, a family with one child can have an income level of \$127,532 (\$108,444 + \$19,088) or less to qualify. If a family has two children, then the income level would be \$146,620, and the increase of \$19,088 would continue for each dependent. For three children, the income level would be \$165,708 and for four children the income level would be \$184,796.

Applications for tuition scholarships are completed through FACTS by visiting: https://online.factsmqt.com/aid. The application fee is \$30.00 & all submissions are strictly confidential. Once you complete an online application, you will be required to attach your 2023 Federal Tax forms and all supporting tax schedules. Everything must be submitted to FACTS by *May 30, 2024* to determine your family's eligibility for tuition scholarship. If qualified, Mrs. Dorothy Aschenbrenner, SJR Business Manager will notify the family of their award.


