Dear SJR Families,

The <u>10th National Eucharistic Congress</u> is scheduled to take place in Indianapolis from July 17th - 24th. In anticipation of this important event, there will be a pilgrimage journeying across the country, bearing the Blessed Sacrament en route to Indianapolis. The pilgrimage will pass through Philadelphia, offering a unique opportunity for many to participate in this spiritual journey. These events offer each of us the opportunity to reflect on our personal relationship with Jesus in the Eucharist.

The committee plans to distribute race shirts to school students a few days beforehand, so please sign up early to guarantee your child's shirt size!



Did you know that individuals and businesses can direct their PA State Tax liability to St. Joseph/ St. Robert School through the Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit program (EITC) to be used as tuition scholarships. In return you receive a 90% tax credit on your PA State Taxes for being a donor! Look at your PA State Tax forms on Line 12 to see if you have a PA Tax liability greater than \$1,000. #### Vice President:

The Vice President, in the absence of the President, shall perform all the duties of the President. The Vice President will also be responsible for setting up and maintaining school assemblies in consultation with the Principal. In addition, the Vice President will serve as spokesperson for the committee heads unable to attend meetings.

#### Corresponding Secretary:

The Corresponding Secretary shall distribute all Home and School Association correspondence. Correspondence shall be saved for three years. The Corresponding Secretary shall also prepare a list of all current board members and titles as well as all committee chairpersons. The Corresponding Secretary will also help with Helping Hands and will be responsible for coordinating all gifts on behalf of the Home and School Association.

#### Recording Secretary:

## Meet the Speaker!



Dr. Katherine Dahlsgaard, Ph.D.

Katherine K. Dahlsgaard, Ph.D., ABPP, is the Founder and Director of Brave is Better - Consulting and Therapy, focusing on the promotion of evidence-based psychotherapy through clinical practice, public speaking, writing, and professional training. Formerly, she led the Anxiety Behaviors Clinic and the Picky Eaters Clinic at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia's Department of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and co-founded the Food Allergy Bravery Clinic. Dr. Dahlsgaard developed the Scale of Food Allergy Anxiety and has conducted extensive research on treating food allergy anxiety. She is board certified in cognitive and behavioral psychology, specializing in cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) for children, adolescents, and young adults, with a particular focus on anxiety disorders and related conditions. Licensed in Pennsylvania and New York, she offers teletherapy in these states and others under PSYPACT. Dr. Dahlsgaard's research background includes working with Dr. Aaron T. Beck on suicide prediction and prevention, leading depression and anxiety treatment studies, and investigating character strengths in middle school students. She has received a National Science Foundation Fellowship award, published extensively, and taught at Chestnut Hill College. Dr. Dahlsgaard earned her Ph.D. from the University of Pennsylvania, her B.A. from Bryn Mawr College, completed her internship at the University of Minnesota School of Medicine, and her postdoctoral fellowship at New York University's Child Study Center.

#### Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) BLOCS Tuition Scholarships for 2024-2025

Application for the Educational Improvement Tax Credit BLOCS Scholarship for the 2024-2025 academic year is now **open**. Before applying, please visit: <u>https://www.blocs.org/scholarship-fags</u> and review the FAQ. It is very important that every SJR family review. We recommend that you apply even if you are over the annual income. If available, your family may qualify for other sources of tuition funding. Families can apply who have students enrolling in grades Pre-K through 12<sup>th</sup>.

The 2024-2025 family income level is \$108,444. The allowance for each child is \$19,088. For example, a family with one child can have an income level of \$127,532 (\$108,444 + \$19,088) or less to qualify. If a family has two children, then the income level would be \$146,620, and the increase of \$19,088 would continue for each dependent. For three children, the income level would be \$165,708 and for four children the income level would be \$184,796.

Applications for tuition scholarships are completed through FACTS by visiting: <u>https://online.factsmqt.com/aid</u>. The application fee is \$30.00 & all submissions are strictly confidential. Once you complete an online application, you will be required to attach your 2023 Federal Tax forms and all supporting tax schedules. Everything must be submitted to FACTS by *May 30, 2024* to determine your family's eligibility for tuition scholarship. If qualified, Mrs. Dorothy Aschenbrenner, SJR Business Manager will notify the family of their award.
